

Can airport lockers store lighters



Overview

Disposable lighters and empty Zippo lighters are allowed in checked bags. Lighters with fuel cannot go in checked bags, except for two lighters stored in a DOT approved case, as per the Department of Transportation's exemption rules. The final decision rests. What are the TSA rules for bringing lighters on planes?

According to the FAA, when traveling on a commercial airline you can bring one lighter that uses a flammable gas (butane) or that uses a flammable liquid that is absorbed in a lining (Zippo-type of lighter). When packing, be sure to carefully check that you don't accidentally place a lighter in your carry-on suitcase or other checked luggage. And of course, remember that smoking is never allowed on board and could land you in jail. Note: This post is written referencing TSA rules.

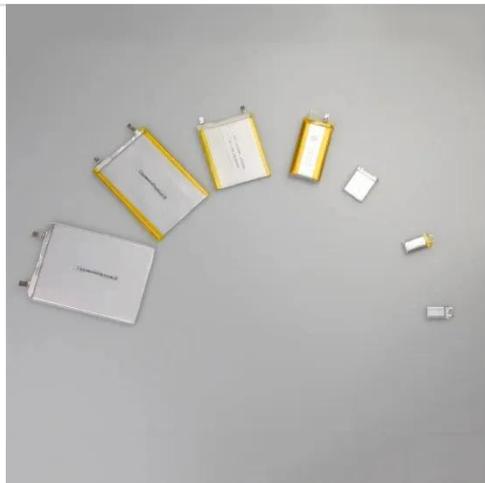
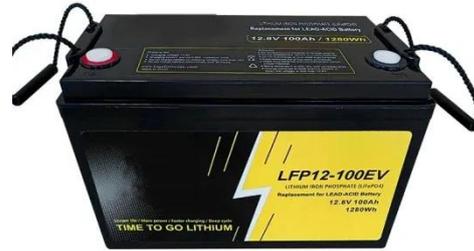

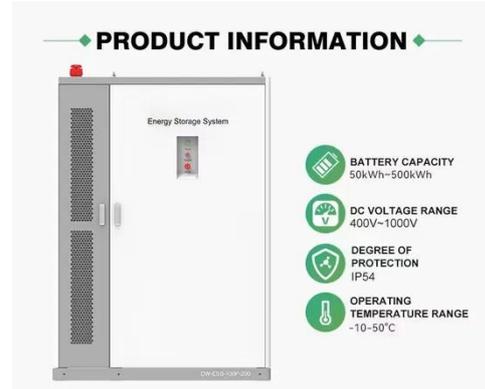
