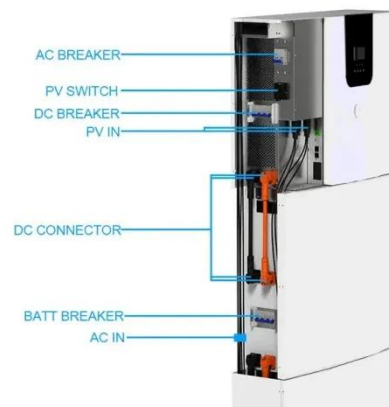
You cannot access photos in the photos app by using the camera from the lock screen or the control center without unlocking the phone. You can view the photos that you take in this manner, ...

When you lift your finger, the Camera app will launch. When you're done, press the side button, and the photos and videos you've taken will be saved automatically.

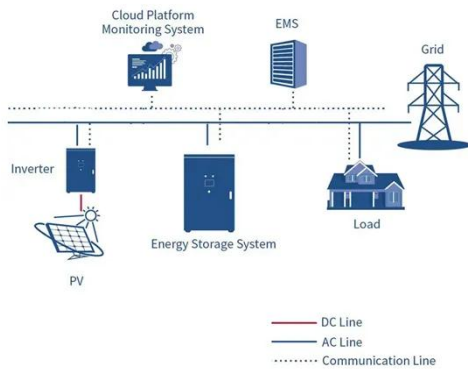
