Colombia's installed electric power generation capacity currently stands at 17,771 MW, with hydro accounting for 68 percent, gas and coal-fired power plants accounting for 31 percent, and the remaining one percent from wind and solar units. In response, the Colombian government has set ambitious targets for renewable energy and a sustainable societal transformation, including reaching net-zero emissions by mid-century through its Long-Term Climate Strategy: Estrategia 2050, accelerating the deployment of renewable energy projects. In Colombia, the electricity landscape over the past 12 months, ranging from July 2024 to June 2025, is predominantly governed by low-carbon sources, contributing to about 73% of the total electricity generation. Hydropower is the lion's share here, constituting approximately 64% of electricity. Colombia mobile power plant import market continues to be dominated by key players such as India, China, Spain, Germany, and Brazil in 2024. Despite the high concentration of imports, the market has shown impressive growth with a CAGR of 23. The growth rate in 2024 alone. Electricity can be generated in two main ways: by harnessing the heat from burning fuels or nuclear reactions in the form of steam (thermal power) or by capturing the energy of natural forces such as the sun, wind or moving water. Former President Ivan Duque set a goal to increase non-conventional renewable energy installed capacity from one percent to more than 12 percent of the energy matrix by 2022.

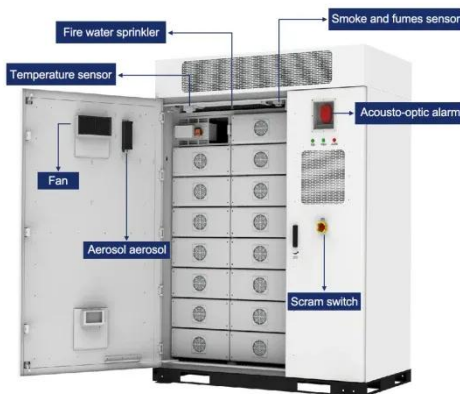
