

Electricity policy banjul



Overview

The electricity sector roadmap also prioritizes investments in transmission and distribution to reduce power losses from 22% in 2020 to 17% by 2025, lower electricity tariffs from USD/kWh 0.18 by 2025, and achieve a target of 40% of renewable energy by 2025. The 10th edition of the ECOWAS Sustainable Energy Forum (ESEF 2025) successfully concluded at the Sir Dawda Kairaba Jawara International Conference Center, marking not only a decade of ESEF but also the 50th Anniversary of ECOWAS and the 15th Anniversary of ECREEE. Held under the theme "Energy for Growth and Jobs", the forum focused on the Gambia Electricity Grid Rehabilitation and Extension Project (GESREP) aims to improve access to electricity and ensure reliability of electricity supply. The project will provide last-mile connection equipment, including prepaid meters, and allow poor households to connect and manage their own electricity. The project is being implemented by the National Electricity Company (NAWEC) in accordance with Section 160 (2) (a) of the 1997 Constitution of the Republic of The Gambia. This mandate is amplified by Chapter 75 (13) of the Finance and Audit Act, 1990 edition which requires the Auditor General to carry out audits for the purposes of ensuring the efficient and effective use of public resources. The project is a landmark in the history of the country, highlighting the importance of energy policies that are credible, honest and transparent. It outlines the current lack of a formal energy management system, highlighting the importance of energy management systems in the country.
