Overview

France enacts critical November 2025 reforms to off-peak energy hours, delays energy vouchers, freezes pensions, and extends winter eviction protections amid rising household energy struggles. Renewables expansion has slowed, and state-owned electricity utility EDF faces uncertain long-term financing capacity. A plan intended to define the country's energy strategy up to 2035 is still pending. This regularly updated guide provides an overview of how far France has come in its transition. France's electricity market has the highest share of nuclear generation (67% in 2020) amongst the IEA countries, which combined with large hydropower and renewables outputs, results in 80% of the country's electricity production being carbon-free. 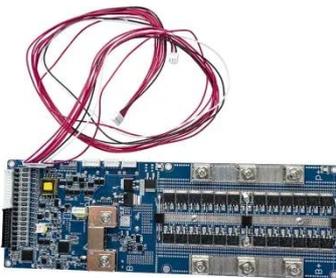
