The United States does not currently have military bases in Haiti for several reasons. Firstly, Haiti is a sovereign nation, and the establishment of foreign military bases within another country's borders requires a formal agreement between the two governments. Originating from the Army of Saint-Domingue (1791-1803), then the Indigenous Army (1803-1915), the Haitian Army (French: Armée d'Haiti; Haitian Creole: Lame d'Ayiti) is the land component of the Armed Forces of Haiti. It is the largest branch of the armed forces since its reinstatement in 2017 by. The expansive military base, named after the historic Battle of Vertières, covers several acres and is designed to house over 2,000 soldiers.

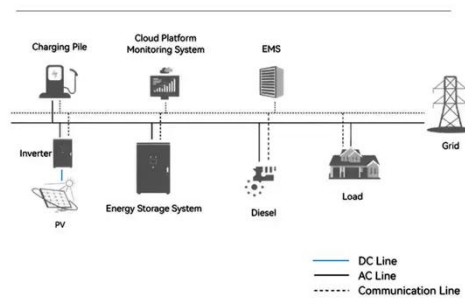

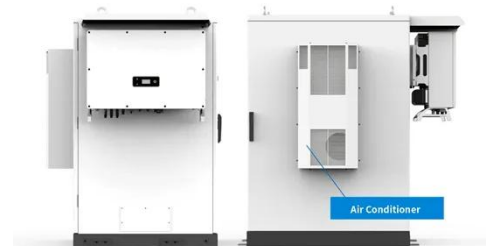
This page gives details of the air base and airfields which were used by the Haitian Air Force. Le Mole Sanit-Nicolas was a secondary airfield, which was used temporarily.
