


# How many years of warranty period does the photovoltaic panel have

Although the average panel lifespan is estimated at around 30 years, most clean energy systems pay for themselves in energy savings in just 12 years.

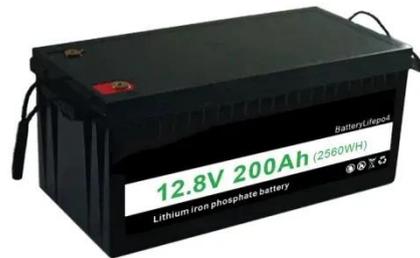
