Technically, no state outlaws or bans solar panels; quite the opposite. Most states have solar access laws that forbid any agreement, covenant, condition, bylaw, or contract that outlaws or limits solar installations by Homeowners Associations (HOA) or other municipal bodies. While federal guidelines provide a baseline, local jurisdictions often implement additional requirements affecting everything from permit costs to HOA. Luckily, many states have passed solar access laws that bar HOAs from banning solar panels. Under this law, a homeowner may not be denied by “any entity granted the power or right in any deed restriction, covenant or similar binding agreement to approve.


